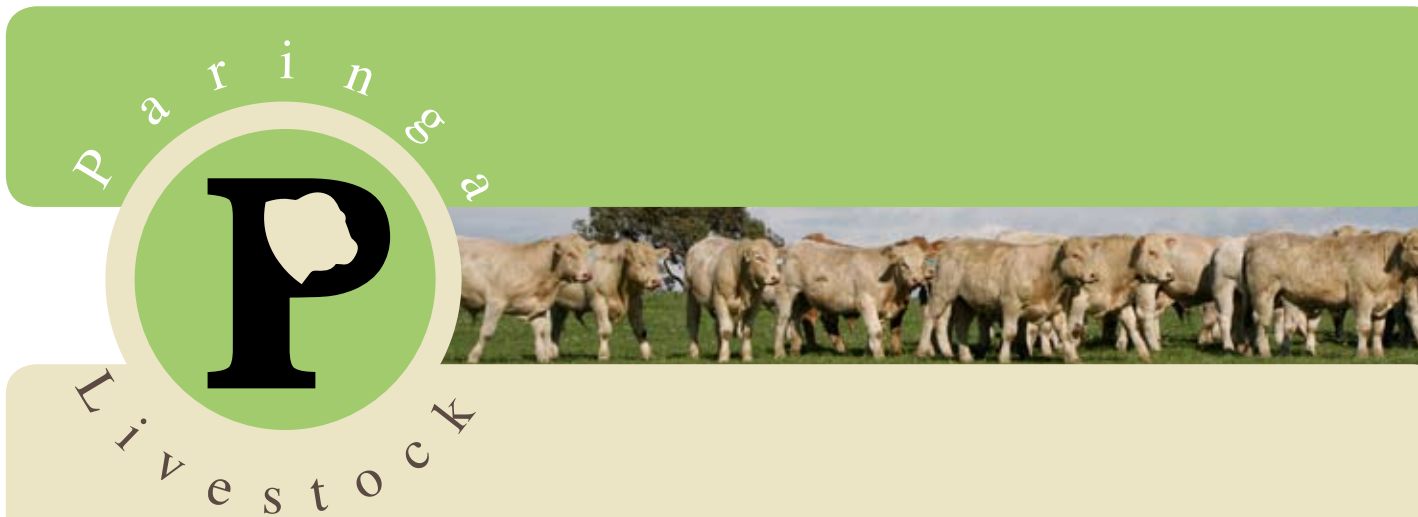

FAT

Why use Charolais from Paringa?

Double the fat cover

The more positive fat cattle are generally described as easy doing or soft fleshing, which can be achieved through extra feed, however within each group individuals can be identified by having higher Fat (Rib & Rump) EBVs.

Soft coated

Paringa Charolais you can see (graph) are on average almost double the fat cover compared to breed average. Visually our cattle look soft and cleaner in the coat than most.

Fine Grain Fat

A butcher from Orbest has said "Paringa Charolais calves have more fat across the primal cuts and the meat is fine in texture. The extra fat cover helps stop the carcass from drying out as many other Euro's do." Our 2009 sale bulls on average boast 4 times the marbling (intramuscular fat %) than the average Charolais.

Greater market flexibility

Our cattle still grow and muscle like most Charolais but they also have the ability to fatten early and quickly when others will not. The extra fat in our Charolais gives more options as you can get them to market sooner, and get the right fat cover using less feed, therefore reduce your cost.

Why use Charolais from Paringa?



Rapid Growth

A major factor which separates our Charolais from all the other European breeds as well as other Charolais herds is our early growth potential. The progeny of these cattle can reach target weights sooner as weaners and yearlings without waiting until 2-3 years of age like many British cattle. The Charolais do not get over fat penalties if they are finished quickly or killed older.

These cattle not only grow faster but out muscle and potentially out marble many other British/Euro cross.

FERTILITY

Why use Charolais from Paringa?

Shorter Gestation

When breeding using a terminal sire we recommend focusing on maximizing the number of calves born alive in the first 3 weeks of calving, as this will determine the ultimate profitability of the beef producer.

Huge Scrotal

Paringa Charolais bulls are nearly twice breed average for Scrotal Size (see graph), an indicator of early puberty but also their ability to successfully impregnate cows in the first 3 weeks of joining.

Smaller Birth Weights

Easier calving means less stress on the cow and calf and a quicker rebreed time. Combine this with a short gestation and cows will calve more efficiently the following year. Paringa aims to select AI sires which are proven for calving ease.



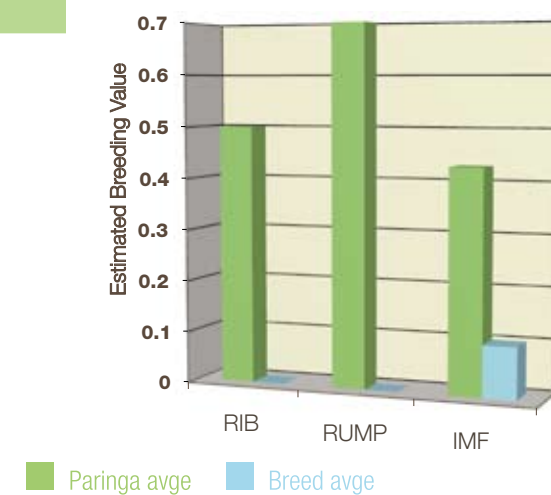

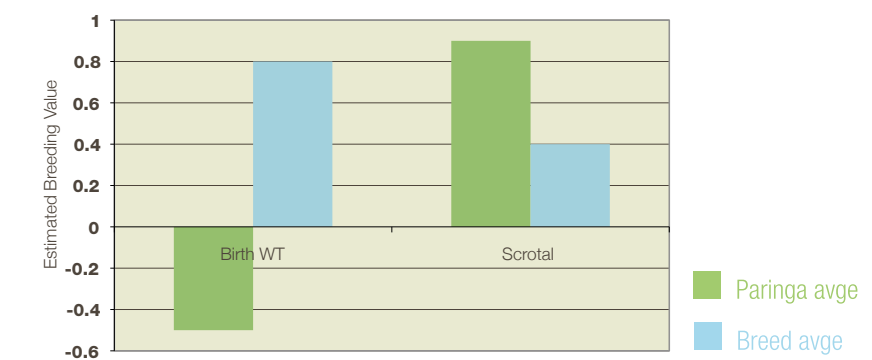
